SUBJECT: Service Disruption for Trace Metals ICP-MS

Dear Customer(s),

On behalf of the Department of Specialist Chemical Pathology at LabPLUS, we would like to inform you that as of Sunday 7th October 2018, the Trace Metal ICP-MS will be replaced with a new instrument. There will be no analysis for 2-3 weeks while the new instrument is installed and validated.

LabPLUS will endeavour to report results on any samples received up until midnight Friday 5th October 2018.

There will be NO disruption in service to Sweat Chloride results as these are processed on a different instrument.

From the 7th October, there will be delays in the following results:

- Aluminium
- Arsenic
- Bromide
- Cadmium
- Chromium
- Cobalt
- Copper
- Iodine

- Iron (urine and liver biopsy only)
- Lead
- Manganese
- Mercury
- Nickel
- Selenium
- Zinc
- Dialysis Water for Sodium, Magnesium & Calcium

All samples will be stored at LabPLUS and analysed onsite once the new ICP-MS has been validated and signed off.
