SUBJECT: Urine Mercury Reference Intervals

Dear Customer(s),

Urine mercury reference intervals at LabPLUS were recently reviewed (last reviewed in 2009) and based on the findings from the review, urine mercury cut offs in nmol/L and in nmol/mmol creatinine ratio will change on Tuesday 24 September 2019.

These changes are aligned with recent literature, other major international labs and are more consistent with in-house data findings. See below for a summary table.

	nmol/L	0 - 100	0-30
	nmol/day	0 - 50	0 – 50 (no change)
